



PROJECT UPDATE: July 21, 2009

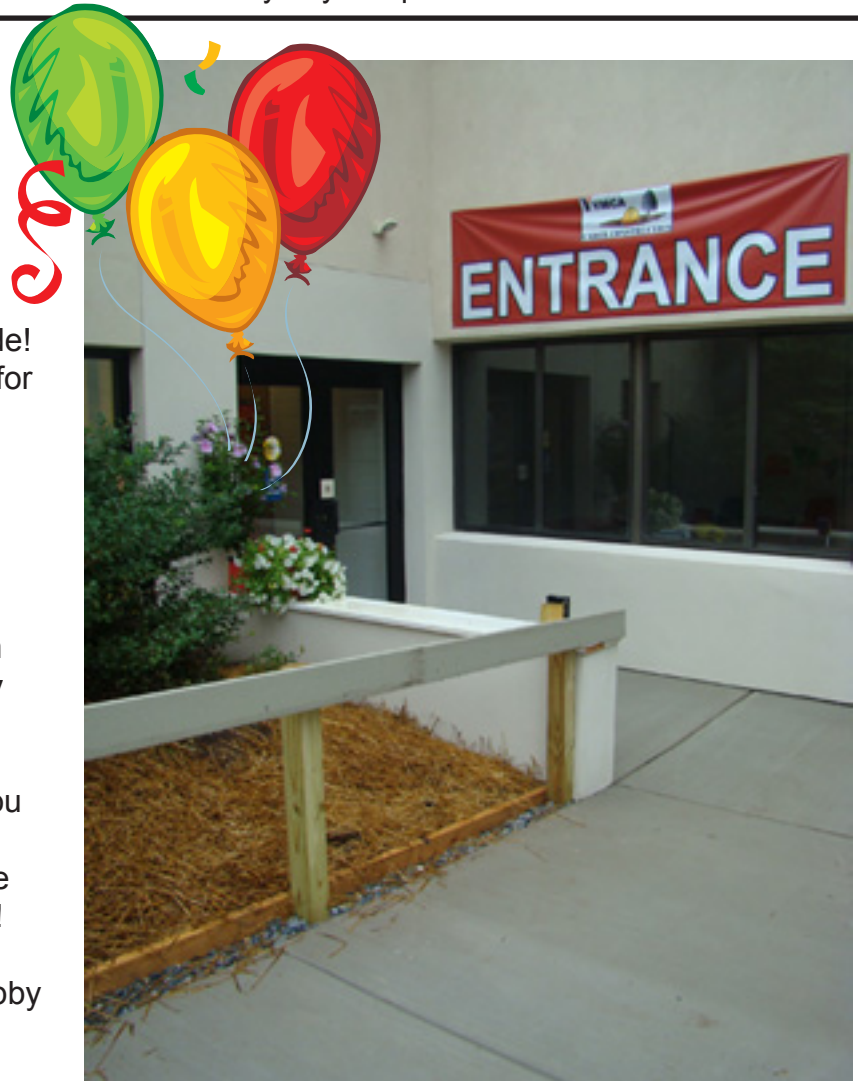
Our goal during construction is to continue to provide seamless service and a consistent level of quality programming with a minimum amount of interruptions. The dates of construction are approximate, but we will provide regular updates and listen carefully to your questions and concerns.

We've opened **NEW DOORS!**

Now, enter the Y through a newly constructed entrance at the corner of the main building just off the parking lot. Look for the big red 'Entrance' sign on the outside! Follow the corridor to Member Services... for check-in, registration and more. There are plenty of signs to direct you!

The entrance ramp has a slight incline, but there are **railings** to guide and support if needed. The **left hand door is handicapped-accessible** with a button on the left hand railing. We've added **security cameras** for your safety – both at the entrance and in the corridor. And there's a **phone** right inside the entrance to call if you need help. If you can think of other things needed to make it more convenient, please let a Member Services staff member know!

This entrance will be used until the new lobby and adjacent studios are complete.



What to watch for... You can see daily changes as you look around the Y facility. Work continues to progress on the expanded Fitness Center and Spin Room as well as the Inez Lenfest Aquatic Center and locker rooms. The foundation will soon be dug for the new lobby and fitness studios.
